

## **TECHNICAL DATA SHEET**

## **FLOOR PAINT**

A decorative, hard wearing coating for interior concrete floors in shops, garages, offices, showrooms and light industrial warehouses.

**AVAILABILITY** 

**Colour range** Over 1500 colours plus Red and Grey.

Packaging 5 litres.

**PROPERTIES** 

**Drying time** Under normal drying conditions touch dry in 4-6 hours, recoatable after 16 hours.

Allow for adequate ventilation during the drying period.

Finish Satin / Eggshell

**Composition** Pigment: Titanium Dioxide, light fast coloured pigments and extenders.

Binder: Alkyd resin.

Solvent: Dearomatised white spirit.

**Spreading rate** Up to 15m<sup>2</sup> per litre depending on surface texture and porosity.

**Limitations** For interior use only. Do not apply when air or substrate temperatures are likely to

fall below 8°C or when the relative humidity is above 80% during application or the

drying period.

**PREPARATION** 

New surfaces All surfaces must be sound, clean, suitably dry and free from anything that will

interfere with the adhesion of the materials to be applied. Remove any site debris and sweep floor clean. Any oil or grease from site plant/works must be removed with an emulsifying de-greaser in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Floor areas to be coated should be acid etched to remove surface laitance, using a proprietary mortar cleaner diluted in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove all residues. Allow to dry. Prime all areas to be

coated with one coat of Macpherson Floor Paint.

**Previously decorated surfaces** 

All surfaces must be clean, dry and free from anything that will interfere with the adhesion of the materials to be applied. Remove loose and failing material by scraping or brushing with a stiff bristle brush to a sound edge. Any oil, grease, polish etc must be removed with an emulsifying de-greaser in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. For surface dirt, wash with hot water and liquid detergent solution to remove any contaminants, frequently changing the water. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove all residues. Allow to dry. Feather edges of sound coatings and mechanically dry abrade any glossy surfaces to provide a key. Remove all dust by vacuum cleaning. Patch prime all bare areas (including any areas of making good) with one coat of Macpherson Floor Paint. Bring forward patch primed areas with one coat of Macpherson Floor paint within 48 hours of drying.





COATING SYSTEM Apply one or two coats as required.

APPLICATION Stir well before use. Apply by brush or roller. Maintain a wet edge. The second coat

must be applied within 48 hours.

CLEANING Return surplus material to container. Clean with a proprietary cleaner immediately

after use.

MAINTENANCE INFORMATION FOR CDM FILE

Between maintenance redecoration surfaces may be washed with a warm water and

liquid detergent solution to remove surface dirt.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

preparation of pre 1960's painted surfaces as they may contain harmful lead. For further information contact our Customer Relations Team. When preparing all surfaces avoid the inhalation of dust and/or metal particles. Wear a suitable facemask. Store in secure dry conditions between 5°C & 40°C and inaccessible to children or animals. Containers should be kept closed during storage. Do not empty into drains, watercourses or access routes to septic tanks.

Apply all products in accordance with BS 6150: Code of practice for painting of buildings and BS 8000: Part 12: 1989 Code of practice for decorative wallcoverings and painting. Under normal and frost free conditions this product will remain usable for up to two years if stored correctly and unopened.
